The „MENTOR ERS: EWC Mentors' Effective Networking and Training Cooperation Reinforcement project" is focused on the growing phenomenon of atypical forms of work in the services sector, driven by technological advancements and social changes. The crisis caused by the COVID-19 pandemic has heightened insecurities related to job security, legal protection, earnings and wages, working conditions, and the participation of employees working as atypical workers, regardless of whether they are working remotely or via platforms, among other things. In addition, the project served to highlight the fact that workers such as these are left out of the worker consultation and participation process. The project aimed to identify and elaborate on these forms of atypical work, advance the skills of social partners for the purpose of protecting workers' rights and encouraging worker participation through a transnational exchange and raising of awareness in eight EU member states as well as in candidate countries.
